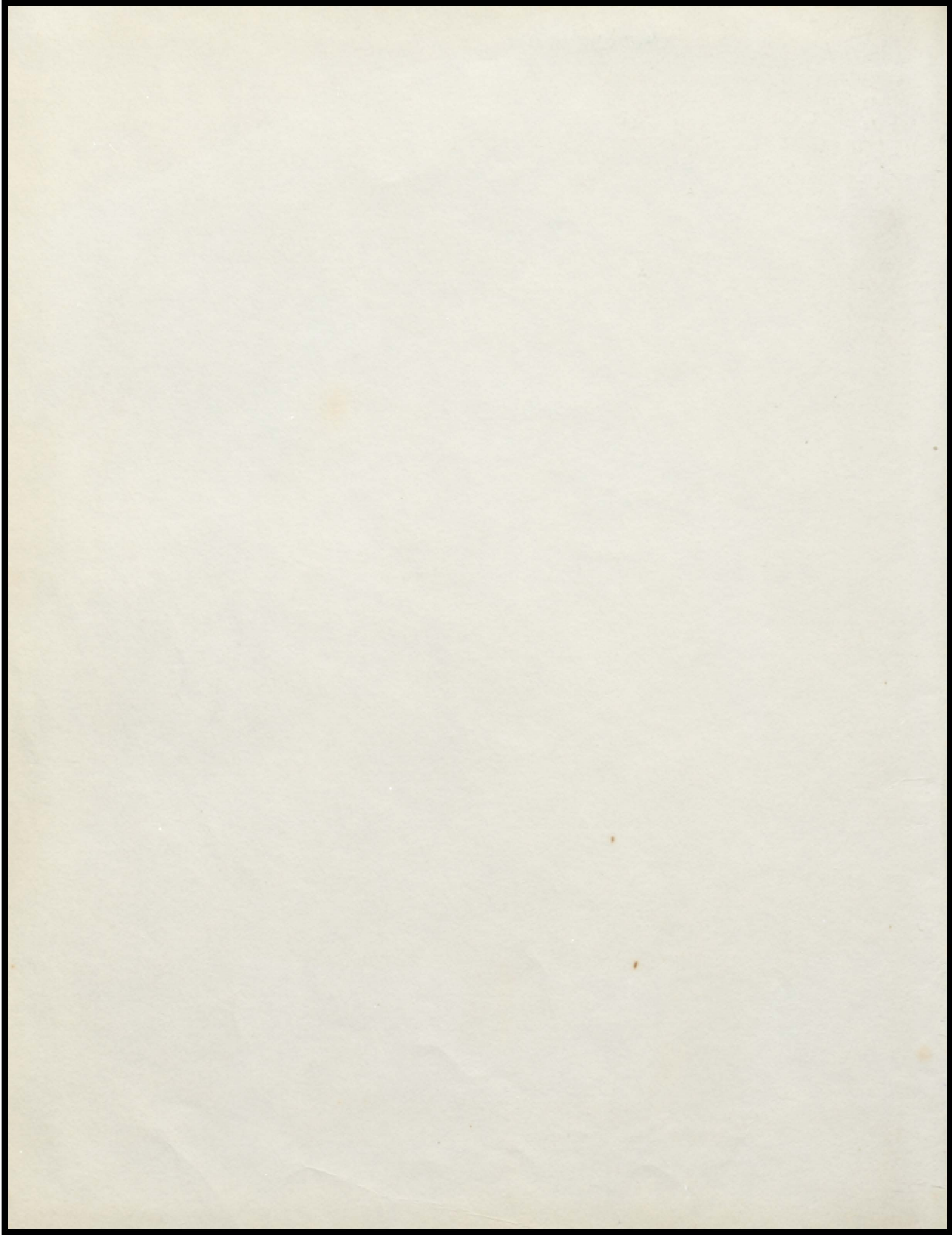


# IN CONGRESS, July 4, 1776. The unanimous Declaration of the thirteen united States of America.

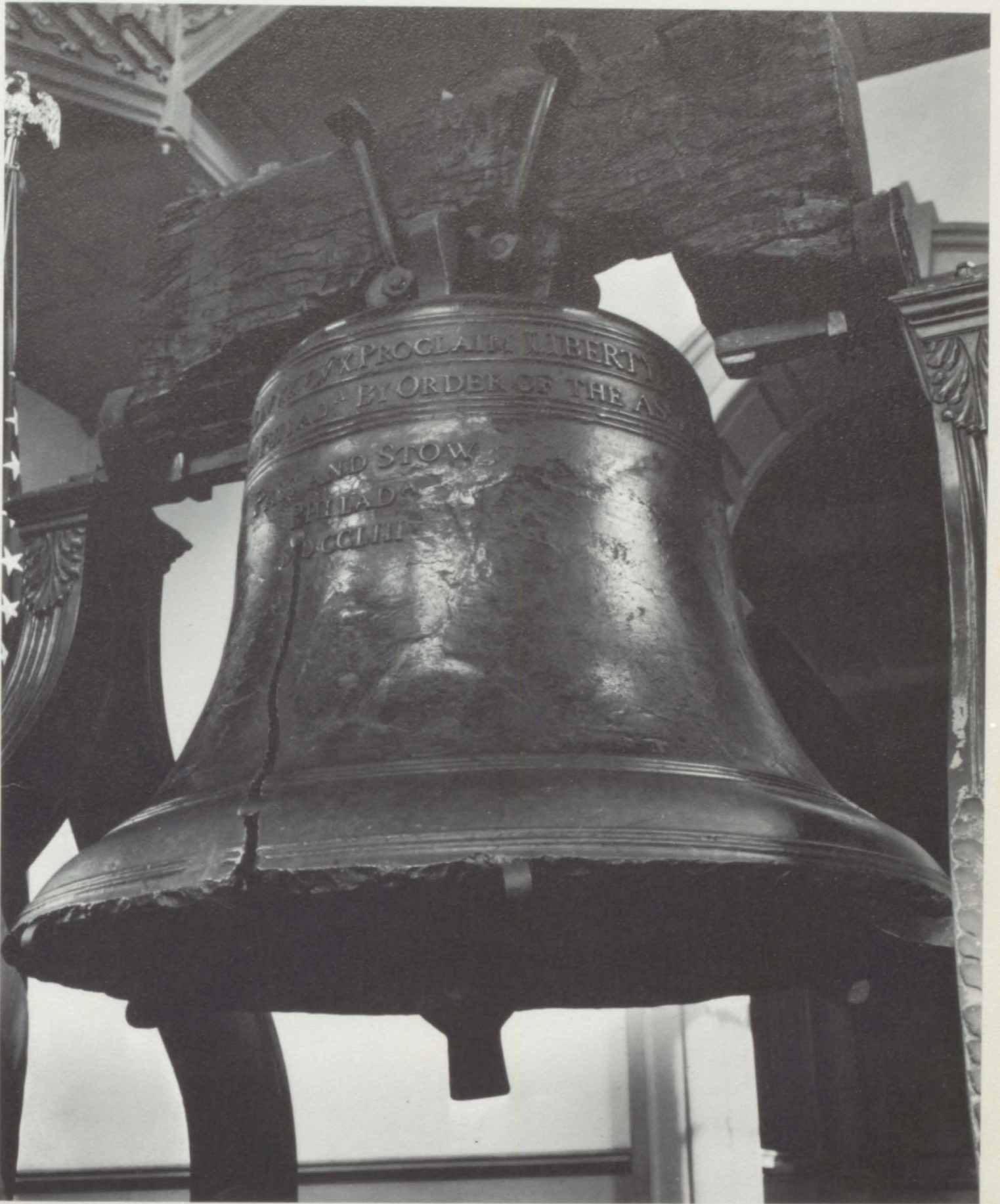
When in the course of human events it becomes necessary for one people to separate from another, and to assume among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God entitle them, a solemn appeal is made to the Supreme Judge of the world for the rectitude of their intentions. We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.— That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed, — That whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new Government, laying its foundation on such principles and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their Safety and Happiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that Governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and accordingly all reformations in such Cases, have proceeded upon a supposition that the People are not disposed to change them, unless a long train of abuses, and usurpations, which would evidently show a design to reduce them to absolute Tyranny, had first gathered the steam to such a point, that a bold push must be given, before they could be successful. We have submitted to a long train of such abridgements of our Rights, and our unfeeling Obstructors of the Rights of the Colonies, have endeavored to extend their Tyranny to this continent, until now it has reached a point, at which a final separation is become necessary. We have petitioned, we have remonstrated, we have supplicated for redress of our Grievances, but to no purpose. A good pat on the back for all thirteen for a job well done.



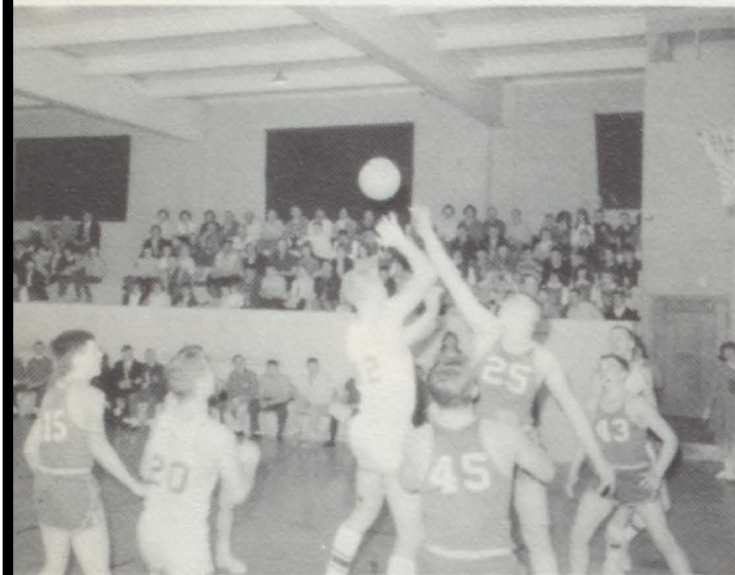
