II's in 54, 58, 59, and 61, and a III in 62.

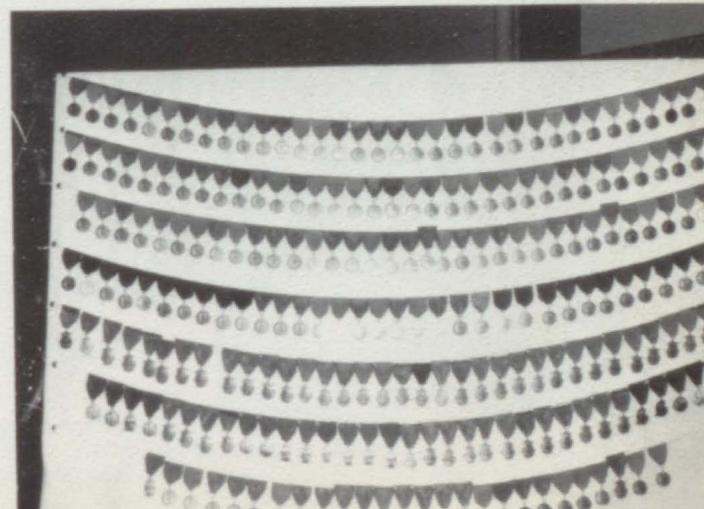
