This football season was an oddity. In six of the games Mayville defeated their opponents in every statistic but the one that goes on the scoreboard—the score. This tells something of the spirit and desire of the 1968 Mayville High School Football Team.

In season averages Mayville had more first downs (73-69) and more yards gained rushing (1461-1342) than their opponents. However their opponents out-distanced them in the passing department (279 yds.-625 yds.) and the scoring department (Mayville 8 pts. per game—Opponents 19 pts. per game.)

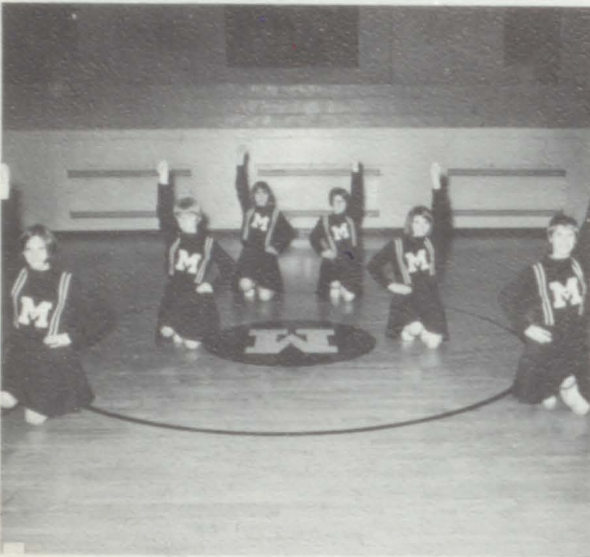

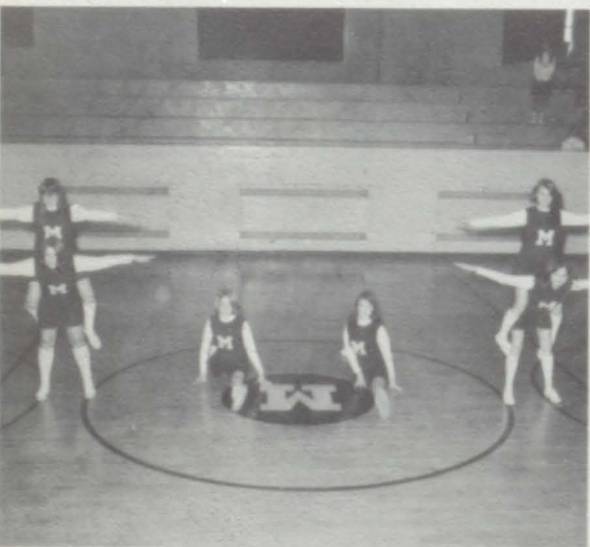
