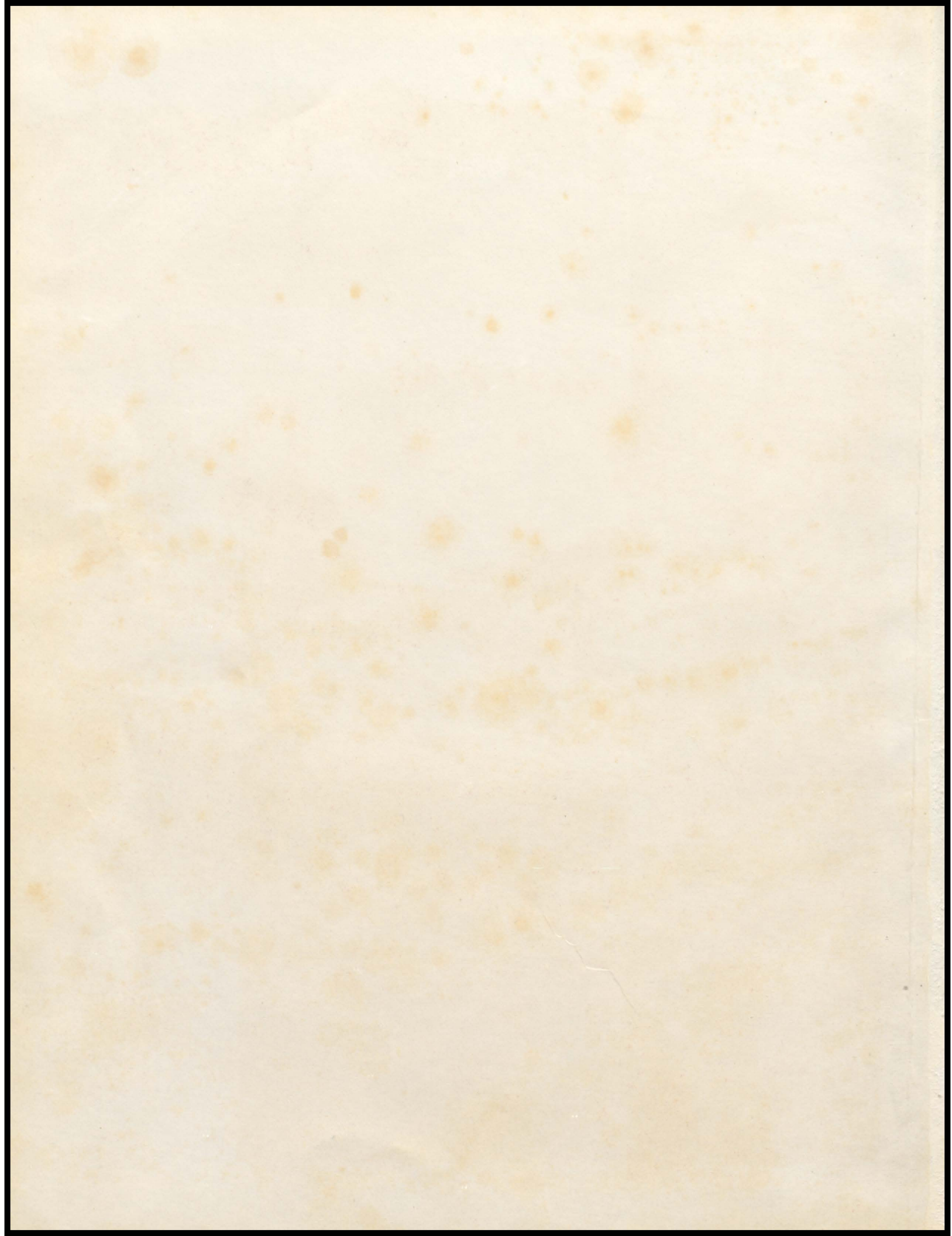

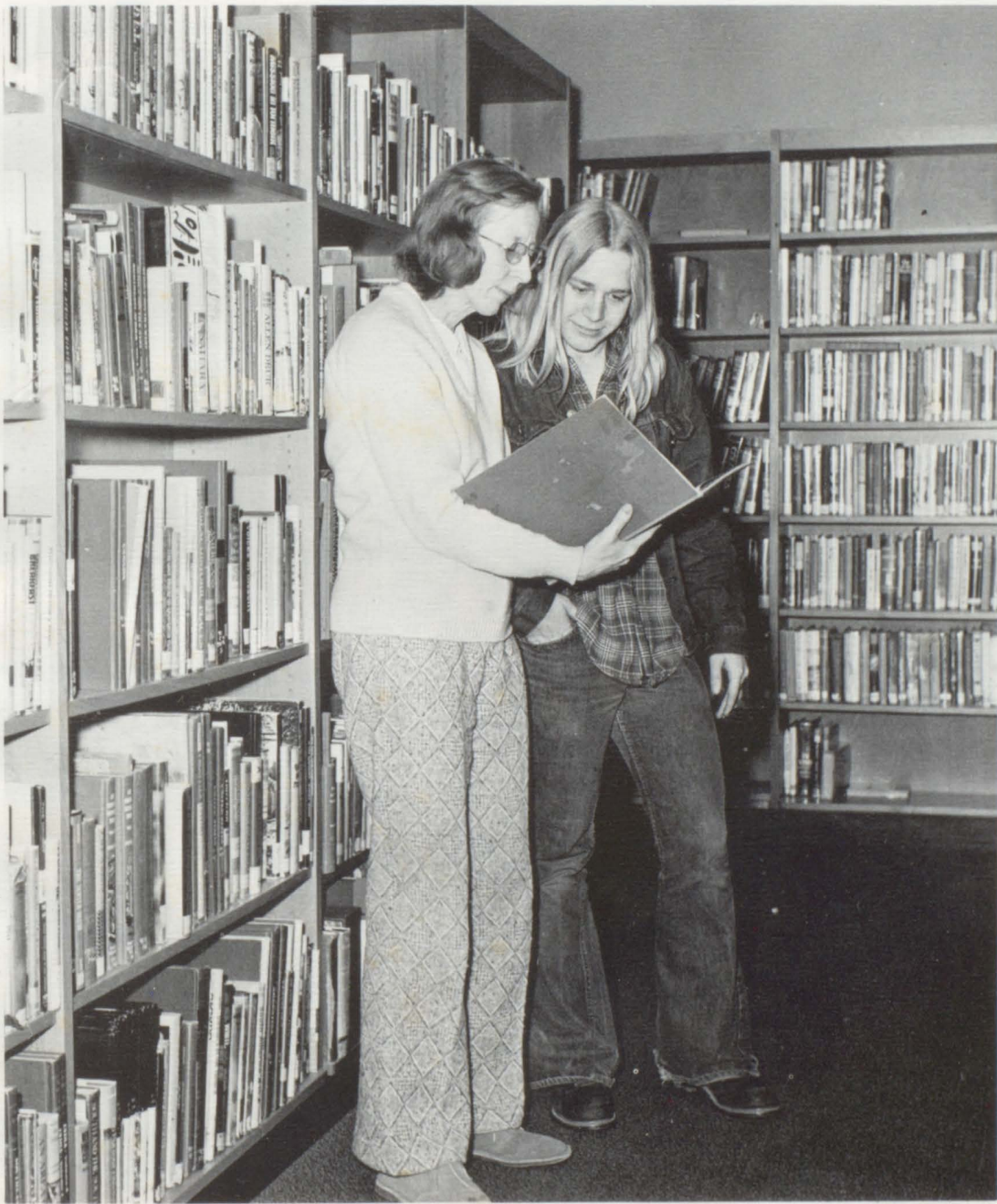

The year of 1974 was another successful year for our library. Because of its continual success we would like to dedicate the 1974 Wildcat to the Mayville High School Library.

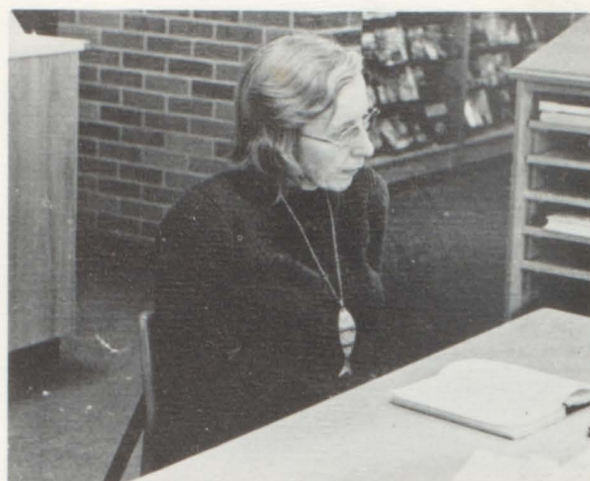
Our library has an excellent collection of books which include a reference section, fiction and non-fiction hard back books plus a wide variety of paperbacks.

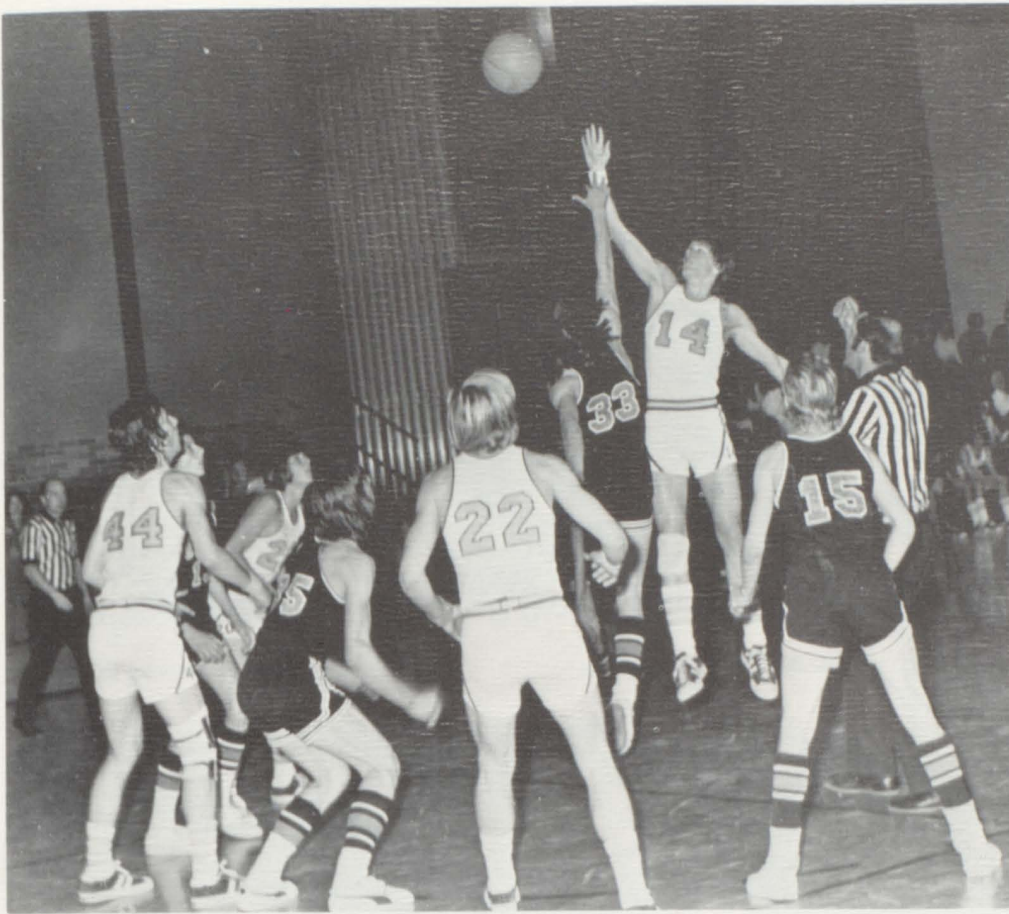
