Mainly due to a lack of team depth and inexperience in key positions the team's overall record was not that impressive. However, several players did give exceptional individual efforts.

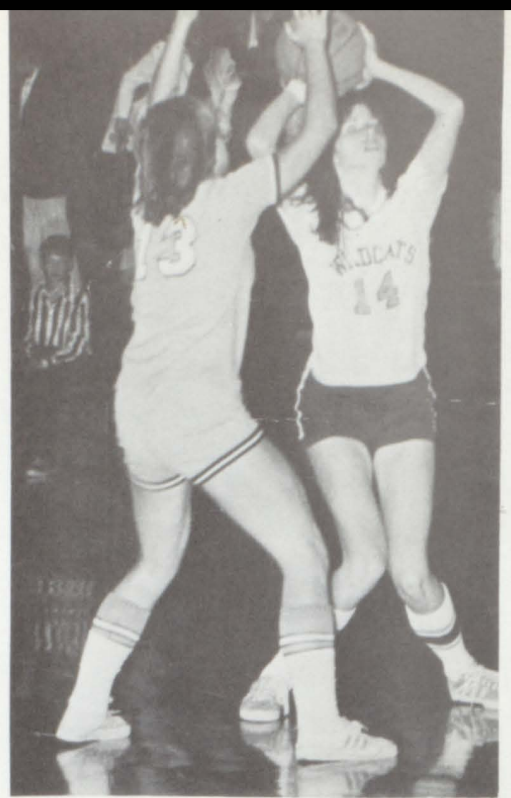
Next year's squad will have nine returning lettermen, five Juniors and four Seniors will make up the nucleus of the team and provide leadership for the younger players coming up.

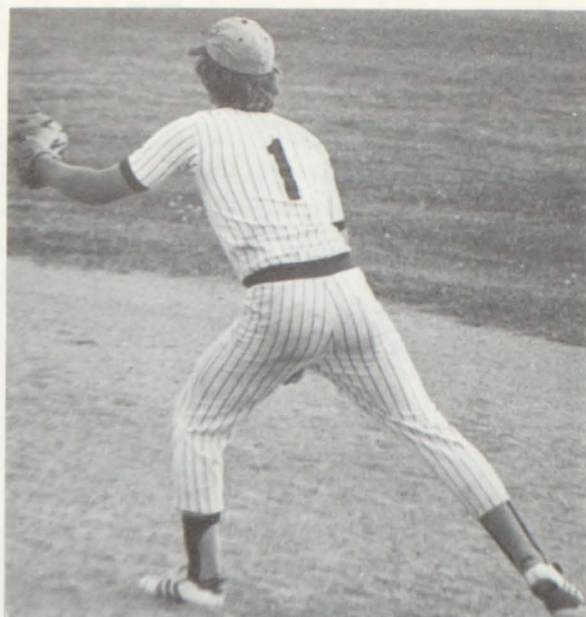
Cats Steal 51 Bases
