Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.

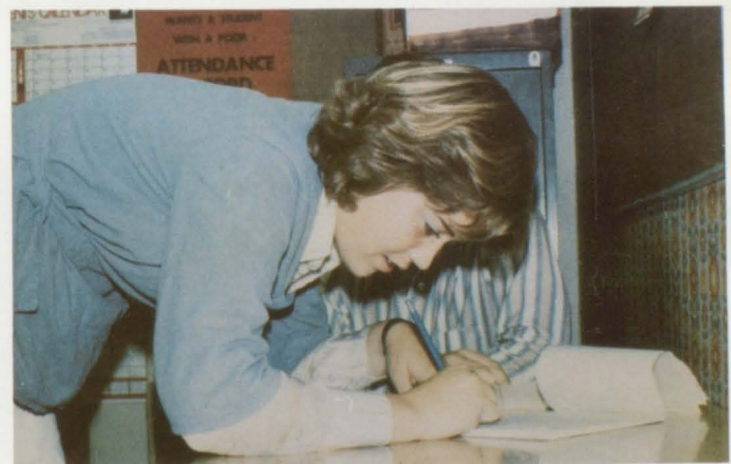
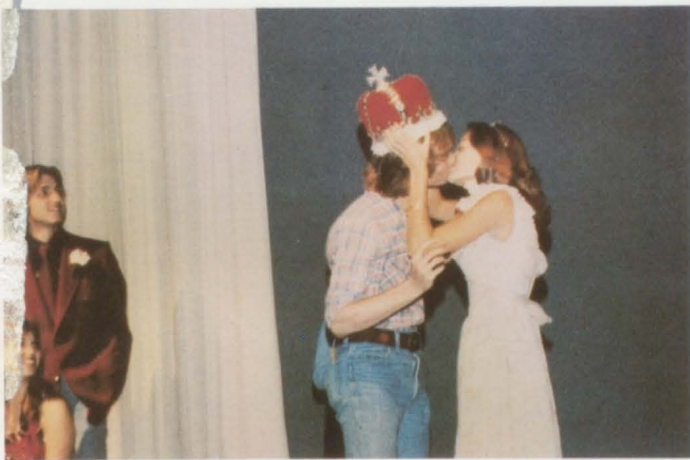
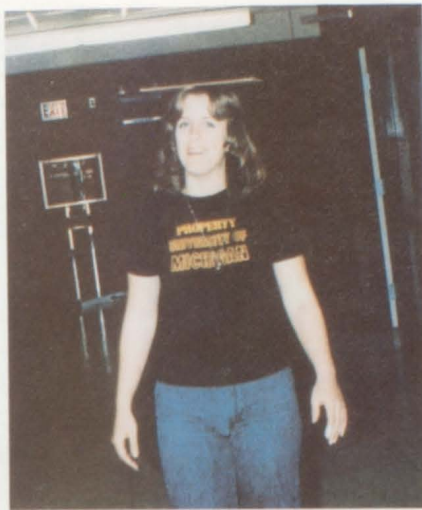
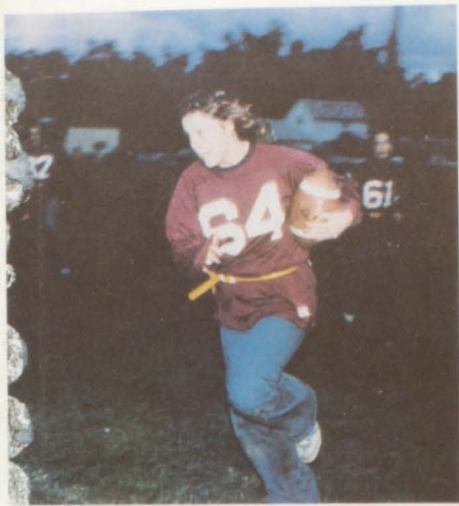

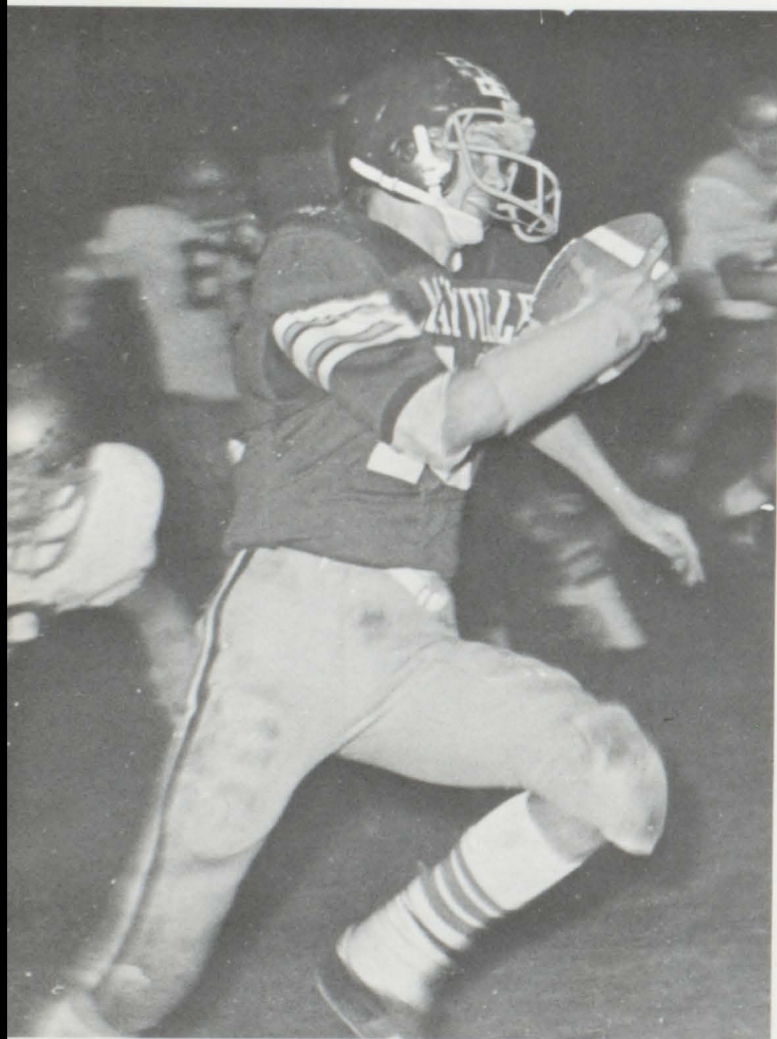

Led by captain Gary Kitchen, this year's basketball team, the only undefeated team in the Thumb area, had the winningest season in the past 29 years.

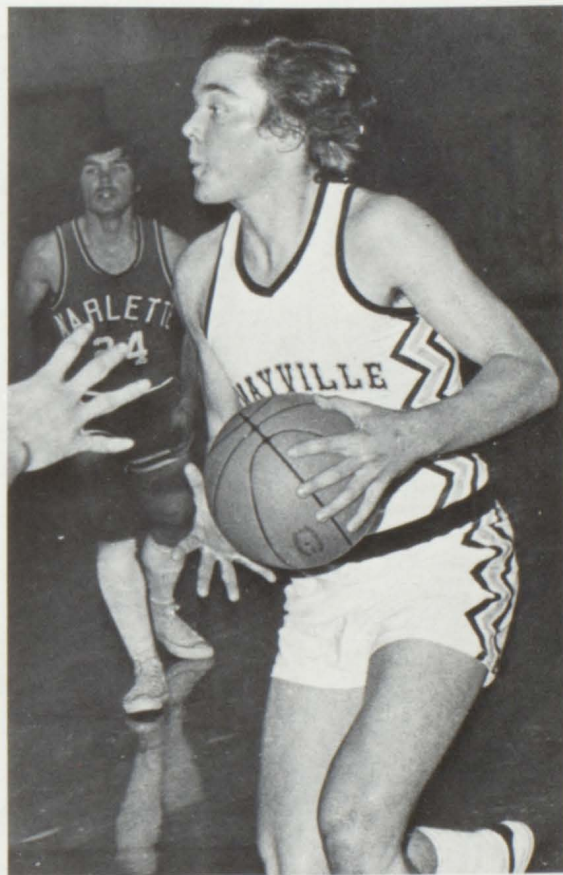
