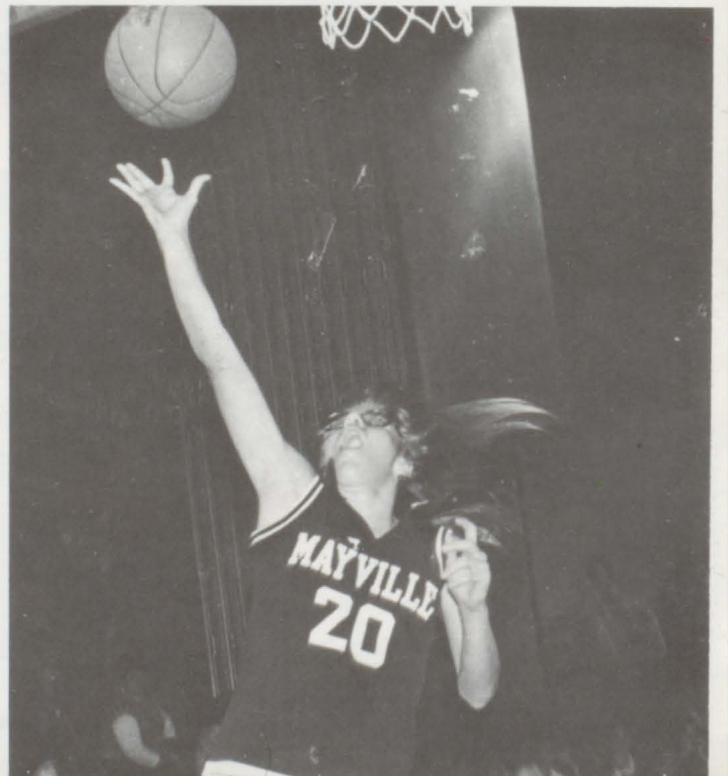

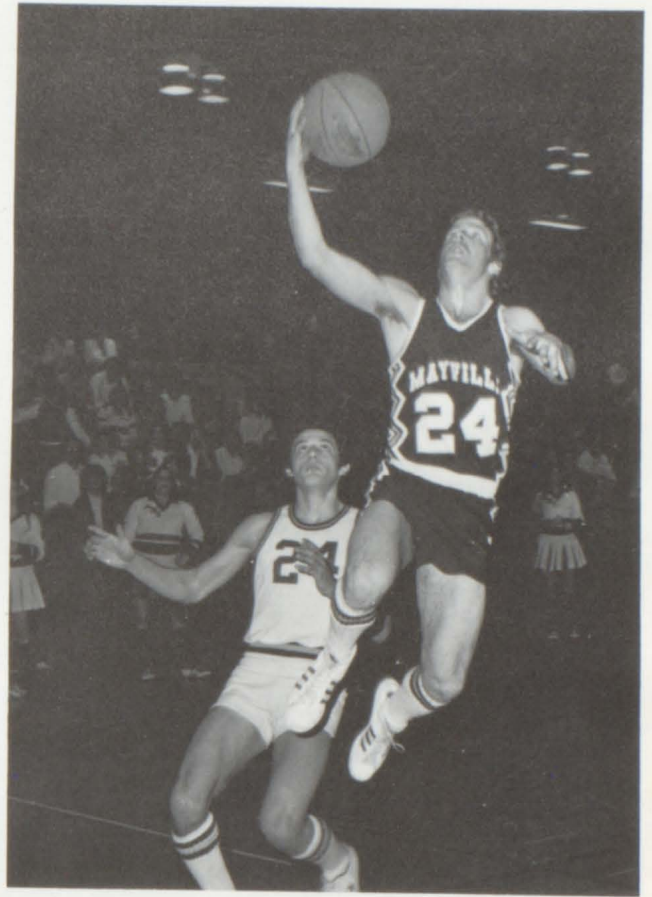

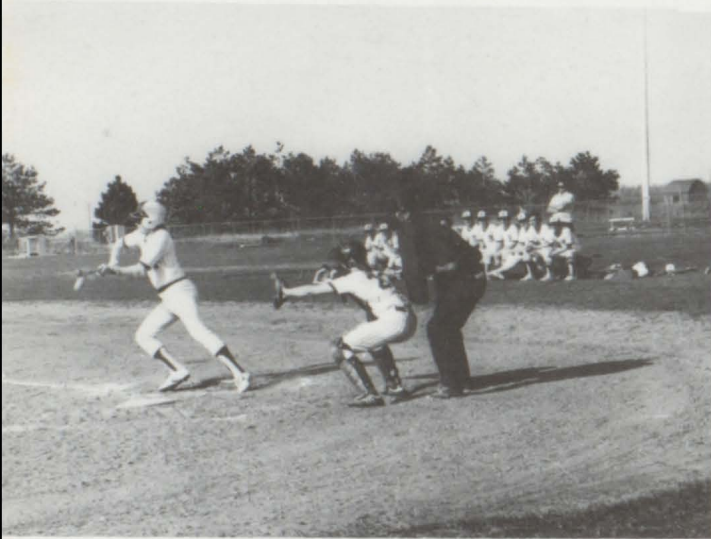
YOUNG TEAM HAS GOOD SEASON

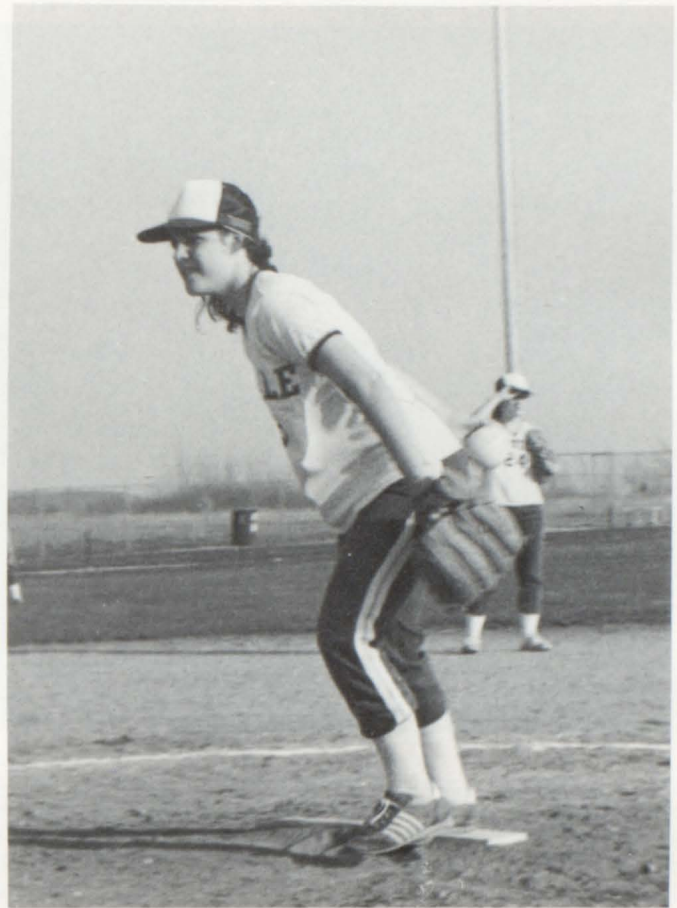

Seniors who will be missed for the 1980-81 season are Linda Kimball, Kay Hampel, Micki Muntz, and Vickie Chapin.





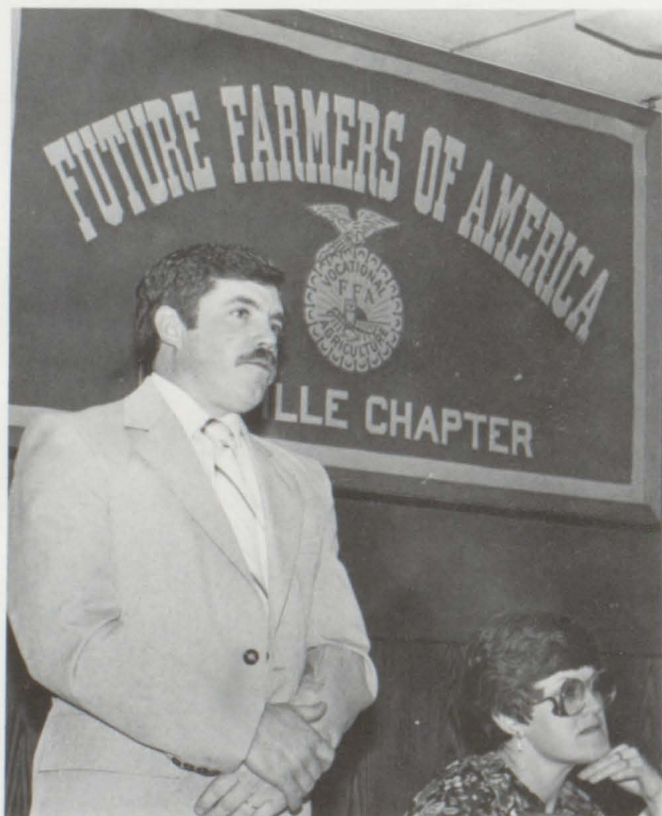
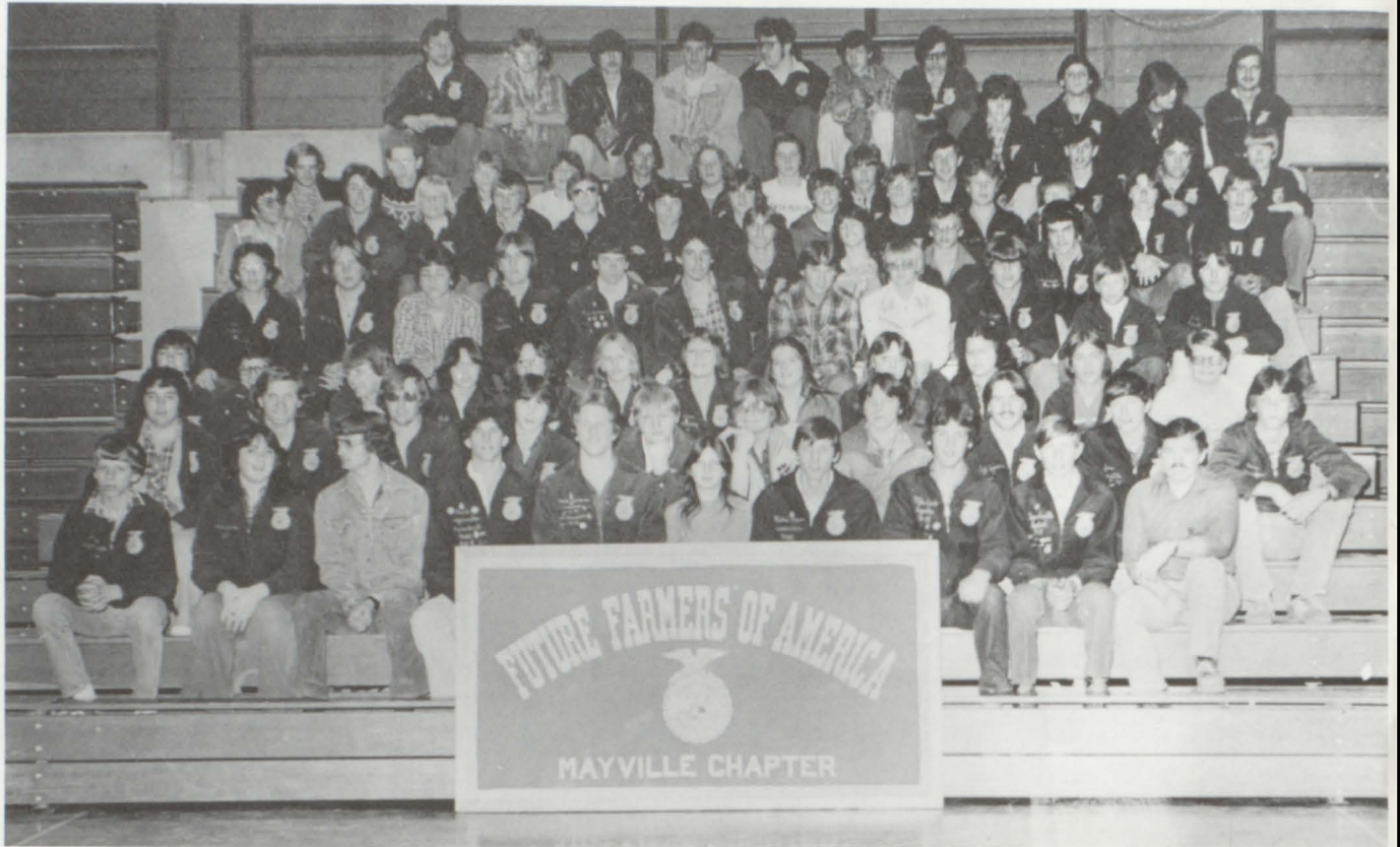
