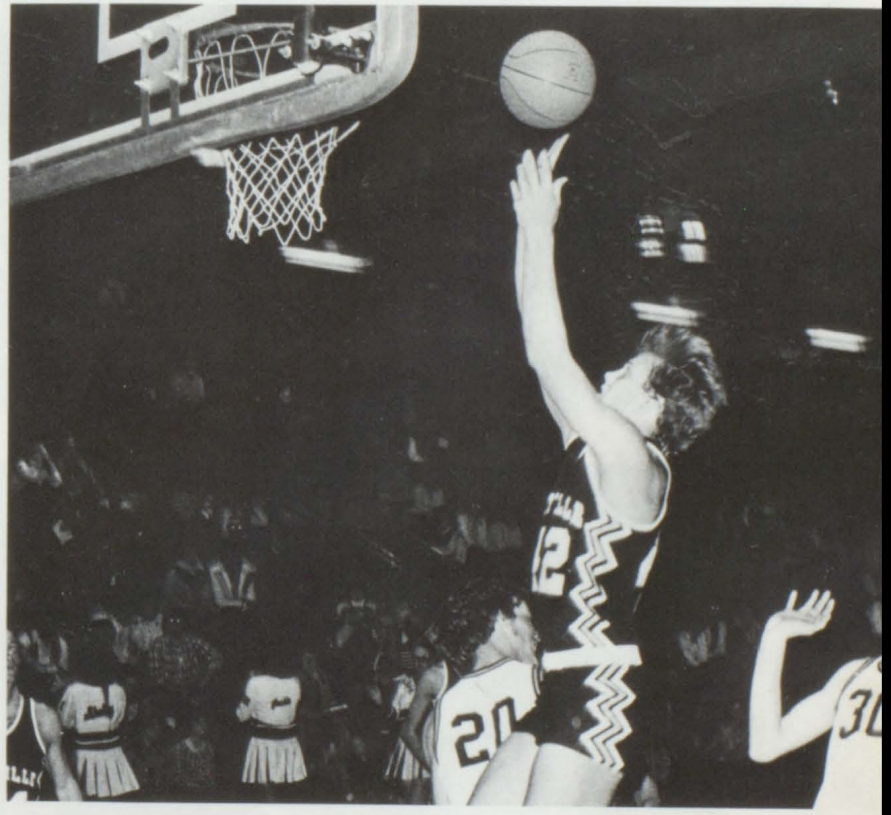
### CATS HAVE FAIR SEASON

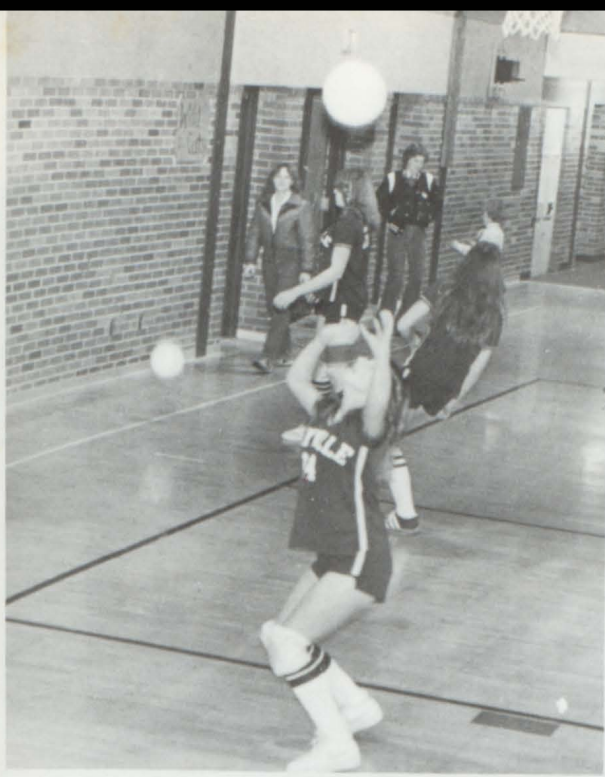

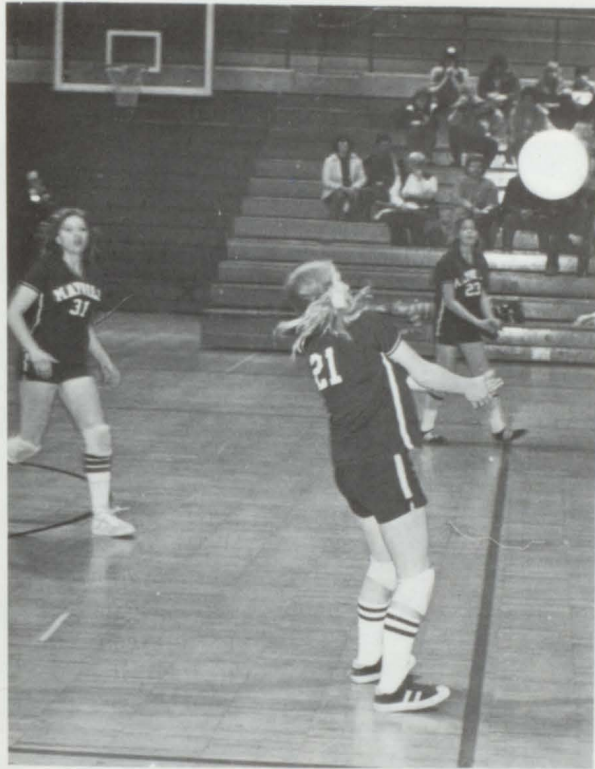




### VARSITY FINISHES AT 500 MARK
