## 1983 VARSITY FOOTBALL SUMMARY

The Wildcats of '83 were very fortunate to have the services of several veteran seniors who will graduate after performing on the Varsity for three years, earning letters and many other awards along the way.

Mark Manning has been the team leader at quarterback for 3 seasons and has made his mark as one of the premier passers in the entire Thumb. This year he completed 74 passes for nearly 1,000 yards. His top receivers were Tim Buckner, Tim Harris and Rich Willis who caught passes for 900 yards. Manning was the team's leading scorer with 26 points and has handled the punting duties the past two seasons, averaging 35 yards per kick.
