## 1983 VARSITY FOOTBALL SUMMARY

The Wildcats of ' 83 were very fortunate to have the services of several veteran seniors who will graduate after performing on the Varsity for three years, earning letters and many other awards along the way.

Mark Manning has been the team leader at quarterback for 3 seasons and has made his mark as one of the premier passers in the entire Thumb. This year he completed 74 passes for nearly 1,000 yards. His top receivers were Tim Buckner, Tim Harris and Rich Willis who caught passes for 900 yards. Manning was the team's leading scorer with 26 points and has handled the punting duties the past two seasons, averaging 35 yards per kick.

Tim Harris has started on defense for three years, earning All-Conference recognition all three years. He was the team's leading rusher with 441 yards and also led the defense with 165 tackles, bringing his career total to an outstanding 300.

Tim Buckner led the team in receptions with 27 for 400 yards. He also had over 500 yards in returns which established him as the most explosive and exciting kick-off and punt returner in recent Wildcat history. He also led the defense in interceptions.

Players receiving All-Thumb C Conference Honorable Mention were Buckner, Brown, Wasielewski and Rod Middleton.
